ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Anointing of the Sick is a Catholic Sacrament which provides strength, peace, and courage to overcome difficulties that go with a serious illness or the frailty of old age. "As soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has already arrived....It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced (Catechism of the Catholic Church).
