SAMS DANCE DRESS CODE

<u>IMPORTANT: Please read the following information regarding SAMS Dance attire.</u> <u>A digital signature is required during online registration acknowledging parent/guardian</u> <u>understanding of the Dress Code policy and procedure set forth by St. Anthony Parish.</u>

The St. Anthony Middle School Club Dances are <u>**DRESSY CASUAL</u>** events for students. The SAMS Club has a **Dance Dress Code** to encourage students to wear <u>age-appropriate attire</u> and dress in clothing that respectfully represents themselves.</u>

<u>GIRLS:</u> wear age-appropriate dresses, tops, skirts, pants (no jeans or denim) <u>BOYS:</u> wear a collared shirt (button at all times). pants or shorts (no jeans or denim)

Attire must be worn to fully cover a person's private areas including buttocks, stomach, back, chest, and cleavage. Additionally, undergarments must be covered including underwear, bra, and bra straps.

Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes must be worn at all times.

Students wearing the following items will not be admitted to the dance or asked to leave:

- Clothing with tears, rips, or holes
- Jeans or denim bottoms (pants, skirts, or shorts)
- Excessively short skirts or dresses which are shorter than mid-thigh
- Tight, body-hugging, body-contouring clothing; no body-con dresses or leggings of any sort
- Clothing that exposes the stomach, back, chest or shoulders; <u>no</u> strapless tops, crop tops, cut-out tops, or spaghetti straps
- Sheer or see-through clothing
- Clothing with references to alcohol, sex, drugs, racist, sexist or other derogatory remarks
- Clothing that excessively sags, is low-cut so that it exposes undergarments or excessive skin
- Sports or athleisure attire

I understand that ANY student not following the SAMS Dance Dress Code WILL NOT be allowed to enter the dance.

I understand that failure to comply with the SAMS Dance Dress Code will result in one or all of the following: denied admittance to dance, notification of parent, removal from dance.

I understand The SAMS Dance Committee makes the final decision regarding appropriateness of student attire.

I understand that if a student is admitted and his/her apparel is found to reveal any of the above, that student will be excused from the dance and a parent will be notified.
