ALTAR SERVER TRAINING

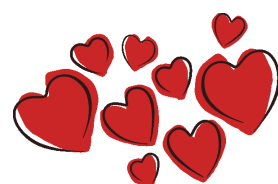
An altar server course will be offered on Thursday, February 14 and 21 for anyone 5th Grade or older who is interested.
