Each year, St. Anthony Youth Ministry (SAYM) sponsors Turkey Weekend, the weekend before Thanksgiving. In addition to baking and carving turkeys for Loaves & Fishes, the weekend also includes a bake sale. We count on donations of turkeys and baked goods from our wonderful and generous parishioners.

**TURKEY INFORMATION:** SAYM, family, and friends will bake and carve turkeys to deliver to Loaves & Fishes in time for their Thanksgiving holiday meal. We invite all you wonderful parishioners to please consider donating ONE turkey to this cause. Due to limited oven space and time constraints, we ask those of you who are able to please bake the turkey(s) at home and we will carve them. If you are unable to bake but would like to donate an uncooked, thawed turkey, we will bake it for you.

**UNCOOKED and THAWED turkeys** (under 16 lbs. please!) may be delivered to the Memorial Center kitchen on Friday, November 16 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. **COOKED turkeys** (whatever size!) may be delivered to the Memorial Center on Sunday, November 18, between 1:00 and 4:00 p.m. So that we may plan appropriately for this project, please contact **Christine Soriano (428-5678, ext. 116)** if you plan to donate a turkey.
