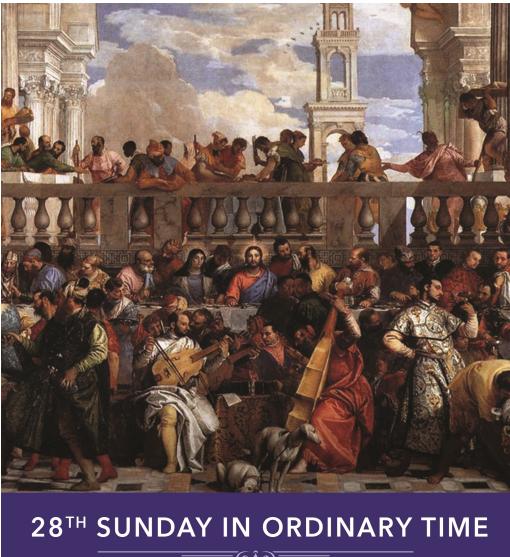

## SOCIAL JUSTICE HOSTS LISTENING SESSION: "WE ARE ALL MADE IN THE IMAGE OF GOD."

On October 18 at 2:00 p.m. St. Anthony Social Justice Committee will host a virtual listening session in response to the California Bishop's initiative addressing the impact of racism. In 2018, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops convened an ad hoc committee on racism in the Catholic Church and out of the committee came their letter, "Open Wide Our Hearts" which said these words:

"Conversion is a long road to travel for the individual. Moving our nation to a full realization of the promise of liberty, equality, and justice for all is even more challenging. However, in Christ we can find the strength and the grace necessary to make that journey."

Recently in celebration of the Feast of St. Peter Claver, the California Bishops announced an initiative to address personal and the collective sin of racism. They have called all Catholics to listen, engage in dialogue and action.

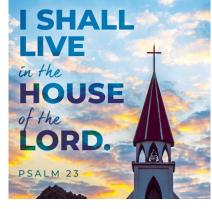

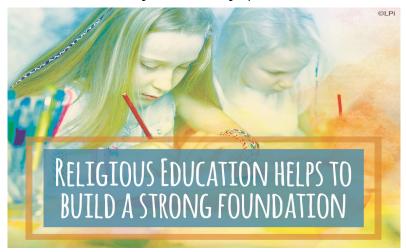
### CFF & YOUTH MINISTRY 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR PLAN

When we feel the warmth of the sun on our face, we feel the love of a brother.

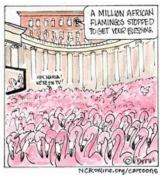
We ask for Your strength to give us wisdom and courage to protect our earthly environment from destruction and overuse. Help us to share the goodness and generosity of the earth with every living person.
