



CFF & YM 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR PLAN

We appreciate your patience as we continue to ensure the safety of our youth families while assisting you on your faith journey from afar. We continue to follow updates and changes regarding health and safety restrictions and guidelines. Following directives put forth by the Diocese and in compliance with health restrictions, Catholic Faith Formation and Youth Ministry will follow a Home School model for the fall consisting of:

- A monthly gathering for CFF & YM at the beginning of each month to meet your child's catechist and pickup his/her monthly CFF/YM packet while keeping with all social distancing guidelines. Packets for each student are to be completed at home and returned at the next monthly gathering.
- A 30-minute, semi-monthly online gathering hosted by each catechist for his/her respective class.
- For individual class information and Zoom times, please see your registration packet, or view details online.
- St. Anthony Youth Ministry weekly online gatherings will continue. Junior High and High School Ministry have been gathering online 2-3 times per week since March 2020. Online gatherings include Sunday Evening Prayer and Youth Nights.
- We will continue to evaluate our program throughout the fall while following the newest and latest health restrictions and guidelines. We hope to return to classes in person in January 2021 but will continue to update you as we go. Please stay updated and check communications from the CFF & YM Office via email and the weekly bulletin.

Along with Fr. Mitch and our parish staff, thank you for your understanding during this time. The safety, health and well-being of our CFF families, catechists and overall parish community continue to be our top priority as we move forward. Thank you for your patience as we continue to work to ensure the spiritual health of our youth, families and volunteers. Please continue to pray and keep hope and faith for an end to this pandemic. Ms. Linda and I continue to pray for each of you and that joyful day we can gather and celebrate together again. We are here to assist you and your family. SOCIAL JUSTICE HOSTS LISTENING SESSION "WE ARE ALL MADE IN THE IMAGE OF GOD"

On October 18 at 2:00 p.m. St. Anthony Social Justice Committee will host a virtual listening session in response to the California Bishop's initiative addressing the impact of racism. In 2018, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops convened an ad hoc committee on racism in the Catholic Church and out of the committee came their letter, "Open Wide Our Hearts" which said these words:



Recently in celebration of the Feast of St. Peter Claver, the California Bishops announced an initiative to address personal and the collective sin of racism. They have called all Catholics to listen, engage in dialogue and action.
