

A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

PARISH BULLETIN WITH A PURPOSE

Is the bulletin something we just do in Catholic parishes? Or something we do with a mission, a sense of purpose, and strategy? It's not a stretch to say that most parish bulletins are treated as nothing more than routine maintenance for the people who are already involved with the parish.

We presume that people who read the bulletin:

- *are already meaningfully responding to the Gospel*
- *and have an interior desire for the sacramental life of the Church....and more!*

Therefore, our bulletin contains: announcements, liturgical calendar and reminders of different events. However, in this process of information we want to maintain the process of evangelization that emerged from the Second Vatican Council's Decree on Mission Activity of the Church and invite us to:

- *Pre-evangelization...building on the basic human needs and showing how these needs include a desire for God*
- *Missionary preaching or initial proclamation of the Gospel...even though it's familiar/redundant, you never know who may be on the margins of Christian life or never chose to believe.*

This means that we should explicitly speak to those who have not discovered their need for God or have not accepted the Gospel. These are the reasons why we care for our bulletin, put a lot of effort in preparation, and look for better ways of editing it, and making it more attractive. Hope you will like the new look of our bulletin and consider being a contributor for it, to maintain it attractive, and as a tool for evangelization and communication in our community.
